



Bunting Display Activity

Use our bunting template to decorate your windows and classrooms during Anti-Bullying Week 2023, or to show your support for our 'Listen Up! (Respect our Rights)' campaign all year round.

Where possible, this activity should be part of a wider anti-bullying lesson. You can find our Listen Up! learning resources and Assembly video on our campaign hub at www.respectme.org.uk/listenup

Simply print, photocopy and cut out the bunting template provided (we suggest at least one flag per person). Ask the young people to decorate their flags with their own messages and/or pictures – these should be as bold and colourful as possible!

An option for younger children: On each flag, write one letter from the campaign heading (L-I-S-T-E-N – U-P) for the children to colour or decorate. You could get crafty with this and add glued pompoms or tissue paper balls.

Once you have created your bunting flags, string them together and hang them in our classroom or school display. Don't forget to take a photo and share your designs on social media.
